Wrexham Symphony Orchestra is one of the most progressive orchestras in North Wales and the North West England area. Founded in 1969, it has grown to its present day membership of over fifty players, and regularly attracts professional conductors and outstanding soloists.

From January 1997 WSO became resident at the prestigious NEWI William Aston Hall in Wrexham for rehearsal purposes. In 2004, WSO was inaugurated Orchestra in Residence at NEWI and then Glyndŵr University in 2008.

More recently, the Orchestra has embarked, with financial backing from COBALZ Ltd, on a project to perform all of Mahler's nine symphonies. We are now two thirds of the way through this Mahler cycle, having already played all but one of his first seven symphonies.
